Easter is not just a day, but a season, the longest in the Church's year. We are given fifty glorious days of spring and summer to prolong our baptismal joy, to bask in the light of the risen Saviour. It seems a shame that after the efforts we put into Lent we don't celebrate Eastertide with the same enthusiasm. On the Sundays we hear who Jesus is, and on weekdays hear about Baptism and the Eucharist, to help all of us deepen our life in the risen Lord Jesus. This Sunday we are with the disciples in the Upper Room, where eight days after the Resurrection Jesus comes among them – as he comes among us.
