Where there is hatred, sow love; help bring peace to South Sudan.

Today we pray for the Church in South Sudan where sadly, conflict continues; more and more people are hungry, homeless and traumatised. Retribution is rife. This young country is on the brink of collapse, but you can help bring peace to the people of South Sudan. World Mission Sunday is your chance to support our missionaries and the Church in proclaiming the Gospel of peace to those who suffer around the world.



The *livesimply* initiative was launched 10 years ago by a number of Catholic organisations and agencies in England and Wales to celebrate the 40th anniversary of Pope Paul VI's 1967 encyclical 'Populorum Progressio' (On the Progress of Peoples). Pope Paul called on wealthy nations to show solidarity and support developing countries. As poverty and economic inequality cause many conflicts, he declared that development is the 'new name for peace'. The encyclical criticised unrestrained liberal economics and called for an equitable distribution of the world's resources. 50 years on, the concerns raised by Pope Paul still appear relevant. In his encyclical 'Laudato Si', Pope Francis similarly addresses the problem of global inequality while also highlighting the overexploitation of resources and humankind's dangerous path towards destroying our common home.

Confirmation


Last call for young people who wish to receive the sacrament of Confirmation next year to complete a form and hand it in to the Parish Office **by next Sunday**.
