‘Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is close at hand.’ This is the message of St John the Baptist, and it also the proclamation of Jesus at the beginning of his ministry. Why? Because repentance *is* to prepare a way for the Lord, to make His paths straight. Before we can welcome the Light of the World, we must recognise the darkness in our lives. Before we can love Christ and welcome Him, we must refuse to love that which divides us from Him. It isn’t about merely feeling sorry, it is about producing appropriate fruit, actually doing something about it, and not presuming to tell ourselves, ‘Everything is fine because I’m a Christian and God loves me.’ Because God does love us, He calls us to repent, to turn away from our sins and seek Him with all our heart. But if we do not repent, then we are those who prefer the darkness to the Light, we prefer to love ourselves instead of the God of Love. This is a disaster for us! And so, we hear God plead with us again, ‘Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is close at hand.’ *Fr Albert*

## Bambinelli Sunday

11 December the Third Sunday of Advent (Gaudete Sunday) is Bambinelli Sunday. It has for many years been the day when the children of Rome bring the figurines of Baby Jesus from their family cribs to St. Peter's Square to be blessed by the Pope during the Angelus. Instituted by St. Pope John Paul II during his Papacy, the tradition has continued and has grown in popularity across the universal Church.

This is a tradition which Pope Francis keeps; a wonderful way for us to prepare spiritually for the coming of Jesus. To mark the Feast, the Exeter parishes will join with parishes around the world, in celebrating the tradition of Bambinelli Sunday. You are invited to bring the Christ Child figure from your home crib (or your whole crib if it is small) to be blessed during all Masses.
