Look, there is the Lamb of God that takes away the sins of the world.

The Church celebrates Jesus Christ as the Servant and Chosen One of God who came to do the Father's will in perfect obedience. Hence, God honoured his Servant and sealed this honour with a promise: 'Ponam Te In Lucem Gentium', 'I will make you a light to the nations', and a mission: 'Agnus Dei, Qui Tollis Peccata Mundi', 'Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world' because he found Jesus

Peace Sunday

Today is Peace Sunday and this year the message from Pope Francis is: 'No one can be saved alone. Combatting Covid-19 together, embarking together on paths of peace'.

The Pope asks us: 'What did we learn from the pandemic? What new paths should we follow to cast off the shackles of our old habits, to be better prepared, to dare new things? What signs of life and hope can we see, to help us move forward and try to make our world a better place?'

A vaccine has been found for Covid-19, says the Holy Father, but we still need to tackle the virus of war, and of inequality, and this can only be done together.

In this country we have an active Catholic peace movement in Pax Christi, which aims at working together to promote peace through parishes, schools and social media. Their website suggests ways we can all become better peacemakers. There are activities for families to do at home, including a peace liturgy for young children. <u>Pax Christi Family Activities</u>
