

Parishes of Sacred Heart, Blessed Sacrament, and Holy Cross 17 December 2023. Third Sunday of Advent Gaudete Sunday. Year B. Psalter Week 3



Who is coming? This Sunday's readings help answer that question. John the Baptist is asked about the coming of the Messiah – is it him? He affirms his role as "a witness to speak for the light", by pointing to the one who stands among the crowd unknown to them who is coming after him. This idea is present in the First Reading, where Isaiah proclaims what the "anointed one" ('Messiah' in Hebrew) will do, and the joy this will bring. The Psalm appointed for this Sunday is the Magnificat, Mary's song of praise at the announcement that the Messiah would be born of her. She sings of the works of the coming Messiah. Paul then reminds us that we are still waiting patiently: "God has called you, and he will not fail you." This is why, on this 'Gaudete' Sunday, we as God's people rejoice in his care, made visible in his promises, fulfilled in Jesus.

According to the charity Crisis, on a given night around 1 in 100 households in England are experiencing the worst forms of homelessness. Forecasts show homelessness rising significantly in the immediate future, with inflation squeezing real incomes and increasing poverty and destitution, alongside rising private rents and evictions. Many people in our Diocese will be affected by this housing crisis but it can be difficult to know how to help.
