

New Teacher Recruitment: — in support of marriage and family life -\_We are looking to recruit and train new teachers to become part of a team delivering the Billings Ovulation Method (BOM) in the Plymouth Diocese. Applicants will need to chart their own fertility to gain experience. Training will be via correspondence modules.

All learning must be completed within a 2-year time frame. Training is organised by Billings Method England (BME) which is the national accrediting body. Once accredited, you will be
