BLESSED SACRAMENT PARISH, HEAVITREE, EXETER 7 April 2024 Second Sunday of Easter. Year B. Psalter 2



After the joys and exuberance of Easter Sunday and Easter Week, we settle down into the longest season in the Church's Year – Eastertide. This period of fifty days is a time of sustained gladness, which comes through reading and reflecting on the Scriptures which describe the risen life of Jesus - not just his appearances to the disciples after the Resurrection, but the teachings from his ministry which reveal the risen life he now possesses. We also hear how the Resurrection made a difference: how the timid and frightened disciples were able to leave Jerusalem and proclaim a message of life over death to the whole world, as we read through the book of the Acts of the Apostles. We also linger over the first letter of Saint John, which ties together so many of the themes of Easter: life, faith, baptism, the Spirit - all brought together in the person of the Lord Jesus, risen from the dead. On this second Sunday, we continue to track through "real time", by hearing what happened in Jerusalem the Sunday after the Resurrection. with the Lord appearing to Thomas. *Salford Office for Liturgy*

Pro-life Prayer Chain



Art Exhibition

Retrospective Exhibition of the work of Grace Furneaux Wood on Saturday 20th April 10-5 at Exeter Community Centre, St Davids Hill EX4 3RG Free Admission. Grace had a deep faith which is reflected in the religious artwork section of this exhibition. She particularly loved painting pictures of Our Lady and the Child Jesus as well as pictures for First Communion and Confirmation candidates, one of Saint Cecilia the patron saint of music and a mosaic of Saint Kentigern.

Grace was a member of the SIAC, the International Society of Christian Artists. S he painted large murals in a temporary church (a disused Nissen hut!) prior to a commission to create the Stations of the Cross for the new church of St John Vianney in Clayhall, Essex in 1965. When Grace and her husband Leslie moved to Devon in 1967 they became active parishioners of the Church of our Lady of Saint Patrick in Teignmouth. There will be many families in this parish whose children attended Monica Furneaux's ballet school who will remember Grace.
