Some parishioners may have had the pleasure to know Chris Wale, who died suddenly in June 2023, and who was a deeply loved husband, father and friend. He

was also a respected member of his church family and a dedicated local councillor who served his community with integrity and compassion. The boxes honour Chris' legacy of service and care.
