

Road closure 21 July

We have had notification from Wales and West Utilities that they will be upgrading the gas pipes in our area. A road closure will therefore be in place on Magdalen Road and Fore Street. Then there will be a one-directional closure on Fore Street. This will be in place on 21 July 2025, and the anticipated duration will be four weeks. However, the part of Fore Street directly outside the church will not be closed and access to the church will be clear.

Record breaking start to 2025

We have been totally overwhelmed by the generosity of our loyal supporters so far in 2025 as we have smashed the record-breaking Orange Box recycling targets set over the last two years. In 2024, our recycling scheme raised almost \pounds 6,000 compared to the previous year's record breaking total of just over \pounds 5,500 and within the first six months of 2025, we have already raised over \pounds 30,000 so far!! Since this recycling scheme was introduced in 2011, we have raised \pounds 61,757.87, which is absolutely amazing, and we are all so grateful. Just imagine how many families we have been able to help over the last 15 years!!
